



The Audrey Tsosie Memorial Scholarship Application

The Institute for Native Americans (INA) through the Applied Indigenous Studies Department shall contribute an annual amount of no more than \$1,000 to support the Audrey Tsosie Memorial Scholarship, in memory of Audrey Tsosie an NAU alumni who majored in Applied Indigenous Studies. The scholarship will be awarded to a Native American student, junior or senior, majoring in Applied Indigenous Studies. The annual contribution is based on the availability of funds.

The need-based scholarship is a one-time support for that recipient for that year designed to defray legitimate costs connected to attending Northern Arizona University as a full time student on the Mountain Campus. The recipient is urged to submit a thank-you letter that is to be shared with the donors and the Tsosie family. The recipient is also urged to volunteer for the annual INA- NAU golf tournament. The scholarship fund is raised through the annual golf tournament and other donations sponsored by the Institute for Native Americans.

Eligibility: The applicant must be a full-time Native American student on campus in good standing with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher, a junior or senior majoring in Applied Indigenous Studies and demonstrates financial need.

Application Process: The student submits an application to the Department Chair of the Applied Indigenous Studies and the department reviews the pool of applications, submits the name of the finalist to the Financial Aid Office. The Financial Aid Office includes the scholarship in the student's financial aid package. Upon notification, the Institute for Native Americans will process the award of an amount not to exceed \$1,000 (\$500 for Fall and \$500 for Spring) and transmit the funds to the appropriate university office that will apply the fund to the appropriate student account. No check or cash is given the student. The Institute for Native Americans, through the NAU Foundation, transmits all payments directly to the appropriate university office responsible for taking payments.
